## The Quickswirl

With this innovative new product, anglers can quickly and securely attach lures and hooks to their fishing line, without a snap. To attach the lure, simply place the eye of the lure onto the end of the exposed coil adjacent to the shaft and swirl two rotations to the base of the product. To remove and replace the lure, simply reverse the process. Quickswirl on/Quickswirl off.

The Quickswirl is made of .026 dia. stainless steel wire and is specifically made for abrasion resistance and protection from sharp teeth. It has been torsion straightened and treated so it is nearly invisible beneath the water, and has a dark coffee colored finish.
