Made for Shade

[1] **Jonathan Paul Eyewear** has released a new lineup of **Fitovers**, to wear over prescription glasses. Blue mirrored lenses along with amber, gold, and gray are available in 9 styles. Retail: \$49 to \$69. fitovers.com

[2] **KENAI** sunglasses from **HaberVision** have a fixed +2.25 bifocal for tying knots. The strong, contemporary frame comes with a streamlined metallic temple accent and comfortable nosepiece grips. Retail: \$77.50. habervision.com

[3] **Banger** shades from **Dirty Dog** have strong and scratch-resistant 100 percent UV and polarized lenses, along with durable form-fitted frames molded from the same material used for stringing tennis rackets. Retail: \$69.95. dirtydogeyewearusa.com

[4] The **Maverick** from **Smith Optics** features polarized lenses that adjust to low light conditions. Nose and temple pads and a durable frame backed by a lifetime warranty make these sunglasses an easy selection. Retail: \$159. smithoptics.com
